

Ft. Pierce Jai-Alai & Poker Jackpot Types, Qualifications, and Distributions

BY PARTICIPATING IN POKER GAMES WHERE A JACKPOT RAKE IS TAKEN YOU AGREE TO BE BOUND BY THE FOLLOWING HOUSE RULES

(1) Texas Hold'Em Bad Beat

- a. Qualifying hand is four (4) 10's (tens) must be beaten by a better hand.
- b. Players must have pocket pairs to qualify with the exception of a two card Straight Flush or Royal flush.
- c. **Distribution:** 50% of the jackpot will go to the losing hand. 25% of the jackpot will go to the winning hand. 25% of the jackpot will go to the remaining players at the table who were dealt in the hand.

(2) In Seven Card Stud

- a. Four deuces must be beaten by a higher hand.
- b. **Distribution:** 50% of the jackpot will go to the losing hand. 25% of the jackpot will go to the winning hand. 25% of the jackpot will go to the remaining players at the table who were dealt in the hand.

(3) In Omaha

- a. Four Jacks must be beaten by a higher hand.
- b. Two cards must play out of the player's hand.
- c. **Distribution:** 50% of the jackpot will go to the losing hand. 25% of the jackpot will go to the winning hand. 25% of the jackpot will go to the remaining players at the table who were dealt in the hand.

Rules

1. All games in which a Jackpot rake is taken will qualify for the Jackpot.
2. The Jackpot fee is \$2.00 max when the pot reaches \$20.
3. At least 4 players must be dealt in a hand for it to be Jackpot eligible.
4. Players in Sit-N-Go Tournaments will be eligible for the Bad Beat Jackpot when a \$5 fee, per player is paid.
5. All players / winners must be 18 years old or older and have a valid ID.
6. Both Bad Beat hands must be the best possible combination of five cards.
7. For Four of a Kind, players must have a pocket pair and two on the board.
8. For Straight Flush and Royal Flush both hole cards must play.
9. The Bad Beat (Jackpot) may be void in the event of the following:
 - (a) Improper shuffle
 - (b) Too many or too few burn cards
 - (c) Foul Deck or too many or too few cards
 - (d) Cards dealt out of sequence
 - (e) Cards having left the clear view of the table
 - (f) The use of cell phones or texting during the hand is not permitted.
 - (g) Discussion during the hand that might alter the outcome of the hand
 - (h) All players must play their hands independent of any influence by another player or spectator.
10. In the event that there are more than 2 qualifying Bad Beat hands, the highest two hands will be paid.
